



## Expectations towards Student Communities

### 1. Partner Student Communities

Once accepted as a Partner Student Community of the WSC-SD, Partner SCs are expected to maintain communication with the Executive Board and other members of the WSC-SD. Partner SCs should identify a WSC-SD liaison, who will have the main responsibility for communicating with the WSC-SD Executive Board.

Partner SCs are furthermore encouraged to

- Submit quarterly update for the WSC-SD Newsletter (ie, once every three months), the respective deadlines for submission are 10<sup>th</sup> January, 10<sup>th</sup> April, 10<sup>th</sup> July and 10<sup>th</sup> of October. A form that shall be used for submission of the Newsletter contribution can be found on the WSC-SD wiki at

- Submit an updated SC info form at least every third month, dates for submissions are the 15th January, 15th April, 15th July and 15th of October. Yet it has proven most practical to submit the respective update together with the newsletter contribution. The form is to be found at

- Create an organisation profile on the WSC-SD Wiki site and upload at least one project of the SC.

Partner SCs interested in upgrading to Member SCs after one year, will be evaluated on the merit of their activities relating to sustainable development and communication with the rest of the WSC-SD.

### 2. Member Student Communities:

As a Member Student Community of the WSC-SD, Member SCs are expected to maintain:

- Commitment to taking action for sustainability
- Communication with EB and other WSC-SD Members through
- Quarterly contribution to the WSC-SD Newsletter (ie, once every three months)
  - Uploading and regularly updating organisation profile to WSC-SD Wiki
  - Uploading at least two projects of their SC to the WSC-SD Wiki, as well as contribution of other resources
  - Adding SC Members as Users on the WSC-SD Wiki (minimum of 4 registered members required to start)
- Collaboration with other WSC-SD Members - SCs & IMs – where possible



- Attempt to attend student summits for sustainability / representation at pre-meeting where the host will attempt to provide funding to ensure representation from at least every SC (when SC representatives are unable to afford)
- Voting on official matters
- Submission of annual report
- Designated WSC-SD liaison
